



River Wye Source Walk

A Source Walk from Eisteddfa Gurig taking in the spectacular peak of Pumlumon or Pen Plynlimon and the source of the majestic River Wye

Wye Source

It's a wild and rugged start to a river on top of the Cambrian Mountains highest peak Pumlumon or Pen Plynlimon.

Measuring 2,468 feet in height the Wye River source and the summit of Plynlimon can be approached various ways. Here we approach it via the Eisteddfa Farm in a Northerly direction whilst hugging the Afon Tarennig. We pass through an old lead mine exhibiting spoils prior to heading up to the summit of Plynlimon via a trail that becomes indistinct although it's enough to lead us on without any navigational issues. From the summit it's onto the Wye source, which offers up an ethereal experience as well as expansive views East. The return leg via Dyll Faen is straight forward yet reveals Plynlimon from different angles making it a great way to finish off.
